KanCare Overview

- KanCare provides services to over 400,000 people
- KanCare serves pregnant women, children, seniors and people with disabilities
- All services provided through managed care organizations (MCOs) to make sure all services work well for you
- Focused on wellness and avoiding health problems



KanCare MCOs

- First contracts were with:
 - Amerigroup of Kansas (Amerigroup)
 - Sunflower State Health Plan (Sunflower)
 - UnitedHealthcare of the Midwest (United)
- Federal government wants Kansas to create new contracts regularly
- Beginning January 1, 2019, Kansas has contracted with:
 - Aetna Better Health (Aetna)
 - Sunflower
 - United



What is Covered?

- You can still get all the services you get now. These include:
 - Doctor's appointments and hospital visits
 - Treatment for mental illness and substance use disorders
 - Prescription drugs
 - Nursing facility care and in home help
 - Transportation
 - All other services you are getting now



KanCare Protections for You

- You can choose your KanCare health plan (MCO)
- You can choose your doctor
- You can change your doctor
- If a doctor you need is only available in a different town, the health plan must provide you transportation



More KanCare Protections for You

- If you have a problem, a member advocate will help you file a complaint with your MCO
- Each MCO will have a group of members to advise them, this will be called a Member Advisory Council
- You will be asked how you like your MCO
- There are still no co-pays in KanCare



Good News about KanCare

- New extra (value-added) services offered by each KanCare MCO
- Improved service coordination for more people with serious health conditions or complex needs
- Continued basic adult dental services
- Same providers
- Same services



What will Stay the Same

- Your current services
- Your Medicaid ID number
- Your right to appeal
- Your right to choose your MCO each year



What will Change for Amerigroup Members

- Amerigroup will no longer be a KanCare MCO (after January 1, 2019)
- Amerigroup will make sure you get the services you need through December 31, 2018
- In early October, you will get a packet with a letter assigning you to Aetna starting in January 2019
- If you want to stay with Aetna, you do not have to do anything
- If you want to choose Sunflower or United, the letter will tell you how to do that

What will Change for Everyone

- Enrollment packets will be sent, beginning in October
- Will contain a letter telling you what MCO you are assigned to
- You will be assigned to the MCO you have now
- You can choose a different MCO or stay with the one you have now
- You will have until April 3, 2019 to make your choice
- There will be a phone number and a form in your packet; you can use either one to make your choice

Members 21 yrs. and older receive \$500 per year toward dental services, including: Dental exams/cleanings twice each year, Annual bitewing X-rays, Fillings and extractions and Fluoride treatments.	 Two dental visits (cleanings, screenings) for adults 21 and older every year. Dentures are covered for members receiving Frail & Elderly waiver benefits. Eligibility is based on determination of need. 	Any member age 21 and over can visit a participating dental provider to get screenings, x- rays, cleanings and filing restorations. Members have a maximum benefit of \$500 per calendar year for covered services. Dentures are covered for eligible Frail and Elderly waiver members at no cost.
