

GEO-ACCESS MAPS FOR 4th QUARTER, 2019

The following Geo-Access maps are generated by the KanCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) each quarter and illustrate the geographical coverage of providers throughout the state for specific provider types. The format for the maps has been updated to reflect changes with KanCare 2.0 and in accordance with the Medicaid and CHIP Managed Care Final Rule.

The Geographic Mapping Reports allow KDHE to evaluate the growth of the network, identify gaps in coverage, monitor MCO compliance with the KanCare Network Adequacy Standards, and provide constructive feedback to the MCOs.



DISTANCE IN MILES

Each map identifies the specialty and—where applicable—population for the service identified. Only providers contracted for the specified service are shown, including providers in border states. Provider service locations are identified on each map as a small dot and colored circles are used to represent the radius in miles from each provider service location (for the identified urban-rural classification). The size of each circle corresponds to distance requirements identified in the network standards.

For each map, a count will display the number of unique providers and locations. In some instances, many providers practice in a single location. Providers may also have multiple practice locations.

Provider Type/Specialty	Description
Primary Care Provider (PCP)	 All KanCare members will select or be assigned to a PCP. The KanCare MCOs contract with PCPs to provide, to their members, primary care services including: Basic diagnosis and treatment of common illnesses and medical conditions Counseling and education on safe health behaviors, self-care skills, treatment options, and preventive services Referrals to specialists for treatment and management of more complex conditions Family practitioners, general practitioners, internists, pediatricians, OB/GYNs, and other types of providers contracted to fulfill this purpose, may function as PCPs. In addition, physician assistants and nurse practitioners supporting the types of physicians listed above may function as PCPs. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a PCP be available within 20 miles of the member's residence. For rural and frontier counties, a PCP should be available within 30 miles of the member's residence.
OB/GYN	An obstetrician/gynecologist (OB/GYN) is a physician who both delivers babies and treats diseases of the female reproductive organs. The KanCare MCOs contract with OB/GYNs, including specialists in maternal fetal medicine and certified nurse midwives, to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that an OB/GYN be available within 15 miles of the member's residence. For rural and frontier counties, an OB/GYN should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Behavioral Health	Behavioral healthcare refers to a continuum of services for individuals at risk of, or suffering from, mental, behavioral, or addictive disorders. The KanCare MCOs contract with behavioral health providers, including mental health and substance use disorder providers, to offer these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that behavioral health services be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural counties, rural and frontier counties, behavioral health services should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence. The KanCare MCOs were instructed to exclude Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs), Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTFs), and Regional Alcohol and Drug Assessment Centers (RADACs) when creating these maps, as all of these providers must be in network for all plans due to the nature of service they provide.
Allergy	Allergists are doctors who specialize in diagnosis, treatment and management of allergies, asthma and immunologic disorders. The KanCare MCOs contract with allergists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that an allergist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, an allergist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Cardiology	Cardiologists are doctors who specialize in diagnosing and treating diseases or conditions of the heart and blood vessels—the cardiovascular system. The KanCare MCOs contract with cardiologists and cardiovascular surgeons to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a cardiologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a cardiologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Dermatology	Dermatologists are doctors who specialize in diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of skin diseases or skin cancers. The KanCare MCOs contract with dermatologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a dermatologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a dermatologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Gastroenterology	Gastroenterologists are doctors who specialize in diseases of the digestive tract. The KanCare MCOs contract with gastroenterologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a gastroenterologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a gastroenterologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.



General Surgery	A general surgeon is a physician who has been educated and trained in the diagnosis and preoperative, operative, and postoperative management of patient care. The KanCare MCOs contract with general surgeons to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a general surgeon be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a general surgeon should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Hematology/Oncology	Hematologists are doctors who specialize in diagnosis, treatment, and management of blood disorders. The KanCare MCOs contract with hematologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a hematologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely-settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a hematologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Neonatology	Neonatologists are doctors who specialize in the treatment of newborn infants—especially premature and ill infants. The KanCare MCOs contract with neonatologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a neonatologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a neonatologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Nephrology	Nephrologists are doctors who specialize in diagnosis and management of kidney diseases. The KanCare MCOs contract with nephrologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a nephrologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a nephrologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Neurology	Neurologists are doctors who specialize in diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the nervous system. The KanCare MCOs contract with neurologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a neurologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a neurologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Ophthalmology	An ophthalmologist is a physician specializing in medical and surgical eye problems. Since ophthalmologists perform operations on eyes, they are both surgical and medical specialists. The KanCare MCOs contract with ophthalmologists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that an ophthalmologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, an ophthalmologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Orthopedics	Orthopedists are doctors who specialize in disorders of the bones, ligaments, tendons and joints. The KanCare MCOs contract with orthopedists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that an orthopedist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, an orthopedist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Otolaryngology	An otolaryngologist is a physician who specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the head and neck. This specialty is more commonly known as ENT (ear, nose, and throat). The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that an otolaryngologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, an otolaryngologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Physical Medicine/Rehab	Physical medicine and rehabilitation is an area of medicine that strives to restore and enhance function and quality of life to those with physical impairments or disabilities. A physician in this field, a physiatrist, specializes in restoring function to people with injuries to the muscles, bones, tissues, and nervous system (such as stroke patients). The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a physiatrist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a physiatrist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.



Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery	A plastic surgeon specializes in the correction or restoration of form and function. Although cosmetic surgery is the most well-known type of plastic surgery, most plastic surgery is not cosmetic. Plastic surgeons deal with reconstructive surgery as well as the treatment of burns. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a plastic surgeon be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For rural and frontier counties, a plastic surgeon should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Podiatry	A podiatrist is a physician who specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the foot, ankle, and lower extremities. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a podiatrist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a podiatrist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Psychiatrist	A psychiatrist is a physician who specializes in the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of mental, addictive, and emotional disorders. The KanCare MCOs contract with psychiatrists or psychiatric nurse practitioners to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi- urban counties is that a psychiatrist be available within 15 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a psychiatrist should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Pulmonary Disease	A pulmonologist is a physician who diagnoses and treats diseases and conditions of the lungs and chest. Pulmonology often involves managing patients who need life support and mechanical ventilation. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a pulmonologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a pulmonologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Urology	Urology focuses on the urinary tract in males and females, and on the reproductive system in males. Urologists diagnose, treat, and manage patients with urological disorders. The organs covered by urology include the kidneys, ureters, urethra, urinary bladder, adrenal gland and the male reproductive organs. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a urologist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a urologist should be available within 90 miles of the member's residence.
Hospital	Hospitals are healthcare institutions that provide patient treatment by specialized staff and equipment. Hospitals most commonly provide overnight stays for people with serious or life-threatening health problems, emergency care, and surgical care. The KanCare MCOs contract with hospitals to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a hospital be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a hospital should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Retail Pharmacy	Retail pharmacists are medical professionals who prepare and sell prescription drugs as directed by physicians. Pharmacists use their knowledge and training to counsel customers on the appropriate dosages as well as provide instructions concerning the safety of combining certain medications. The KanCare MCOs contract with retail pharmacies to provide these services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that a retail pharmacy be available within 10 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, a retail pharmacy should be available within 30 miles of the member's residence.
Optometry	An optometrist is a health care professional who is licensed to provide primary eye care services. The KanCare MCOs contract with optometrists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is that an optometrist be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, an optometrist should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.



Dental Primary Care	Dental primary care includes dental procedures or protocols that attempt to preserve oral hard tissues (teeth) and soft tissues (gums) in good health. Common examples of services include checkups, cleanings, fluoride treatment and sealants. The KanCare MCOs contract with dental providers, including general dentistry practitioners and pediatric dentists, to provide primary dental care services to their members. The access standard for urban and semi-urban counties is that dental primary care be available within 20 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, dental primary care should be available within 30 miles of the member's residence.
Physical Therapy	A physical therapist is a health care professional who is licensed to provide services necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of impairments, functional limitations, disabilities or changes in physical function and health status. Physical therapy services must be prescribed by a physician and performed be either a registered physical therapist or by a certified physical therapy assistant working under the supervision of a registered physical therapist. The KanCare MCOs contract with physical therapists, which may be hospital-based, to provide these services to their members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is that physical therapy be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, physical therapy should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Occupational Therapy	Occupational therapy is medically prescribed treatment concerned with improving or restoring functions which have been impaired by illness or injury or where function has been permanently lost or reduced by illness or injury to improve the individual's ability to perform those tasks required for independent functioning. A qualified occupational therapist is an individual who is licensed by the Kansas Board of Healing Arts or jurisdiction in which the service is provided. Occupational therapy services may also be provided by an occupational therapy assistant (OTA) working under the supervision of an occupational therapist. The KanCare MCOs contract with occupational therapists, which may be hospital-based, to provide these services to their members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is that occupational therapy be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, occupational therapy should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Speech Therapy	Speech-language pathology (SLP) services are those services provided within the scope of practice of speech-language pathologists and necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of speech and language disorders which result in communication disabilities and for the diagnosis and treatment of swallowing disorders (dysphagia), regardless of the presence of a communication disability. According to the Kansas Medicaid State Plan, speech therapy must be provided by a speech pathologist with a certificate of clinical competence from the American Speech and Hearing Association. The KanCare MCOs contract with speech therapists to provide these services to their members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is that speech therapy be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, speech therapy should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
X-Ray	Radiological services provided either by a diagnostic x-ray provider or a mobile x-ray clinic. The KanCare MCOs contract with x-ray providers to provide these services to their members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is that an x-ray be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, x-ray should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Lab	A laboratory certified to perform diagnostic and/or clinical tests independent of an institution or a physician's office. Independent labs, pathology labs, hospital-based and other laboratory providers may be included if they are contracted by the MCOs to provide lab services to KanCare members. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is for lab services to be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, lab services should be available within 30 miles of the member's residence.



Adult Day Care	Adult Day Care is a service available to those members currently receiving services under the Frail Elderly Home and Community Based Services Waiver program. This service includes: basic nursing care as delegated or provided by a licensed nurse and as identified in the service plan, daily supervision/physical assistance with certain activities of daily living (ADLs) limited to eating mobility and includes the following (as identified in the Customer Service Worksheet): transfer, bathing, dressing. The service must be performed in a State licensed free-standing Adult Day Care Facility, Nursing Facility, Assisted Living Facility, Residential Health Care Facility or Home Plus. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is for adult day care services to be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, adult day care services should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
Day Supports	Day Supports is a service available to those members currently receiving services under the Intellectual/Developmental Disability Home and Community Based Services Waiver program. Day Supports are regularly occurring activities that provide a sense of participation, accomplishment, personal reward, personal contribution, or remuneration and thereby serve to maintain or increase adaptive capabilities, productivity, independence or integration and participation in the community. Day Supports also includes the provision of pre-vocational services which are aimed at preparing a participant for paid or unpaid employment but are not job-task oriented. These waiver services must be provided in person by licensed community service provider staff. The access standard for both urban and rural counties is for day support services to be available within 30 miles of the member's residence. For densely settled rural, rural and frontier counties, day support services should be available within 60 miles of the member's residence.
