



Medical Coverage for Pregnant Women

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

This program is available to pregnant women. To be eligible, you must be a Kansas resident with the intent to stay in Kansas. You also must be a US citizen or qualified alien. Verification of citizenship and identity is required. See the [Citizenship and Identity Requirements](#) fact sheet for more information. If you are not a US qualified alien you may be eligible for a program called SOBRA. You can get more information regarding SOBRA at your local Department for Children and Families (DCF) office.

FAMILY SIZE

Your family size is determined by including you, your unborn child, and the father of the unborn child (if he lives in the home with you). Your family size must also include your parents if you are a minor and living with your parents.

RESOURCES

No resource test is applicable.

INCOME

Your earned and unearned income and the earned and unearned income of the father of the unborn child (if he lives in the home with you) must be included on your application. If you are a minor living with your parents their income must also be included. This includes wages from a job, unemployment benefits, Social Security (except SSI), VA benefits, and child support. Unearned income is counted in full. A \$200 work expense deduction is allowed for each employed person. The eligibility worker will determine the income that is counted to determine your eligibility.

INCOME STANDARD

The monthly countable income of your family is compared to the monthly income standards listed below, which are based on family size. If the income is below the appropriate standard, you would qualify for Medical coverage.
