The plan has been a part of PBS Medicaid Services for about 10 years.

1. PCP strength plan identifies their strengths and builds on that.  
Description: Strengths Based Individualized Planning Process and Report which is Driven by Individual and their Dream. Strengths, Needs, Preferences, Goals, and Action Steps are all Included in this Dynamic Plan which is updated as needed
2. Environmental function assessment. Description: Across Environments, Times, Caretakers, Activities--Focus on Determining Function of Behavior, Setting Events, Training Needs, Contexts, Environmental Issues, Operationalize Behaviors, Strengths, Challenges, and Essentially What is Working and What is Not Working.
3. PBS Treatment Description: Implementation of Function Based Interventions, Training of Care Giver, Coaching, Monitoring, Enhancing Interventions, Observing for Fidelity of Implementation, Data Collection Supports and Monitoring

There is no limit as to how long a child (up to 21) can remain on the services.
