Speaker and Topic: Basics on the PD Waiver with John Barry

The program serves those 16-64 years old. Target group are those found disabled by Social Security standards, and meet Medicaid nursing facility threshold.

Primary diagnosis of SPMI or I/DD go to the appropriate program. Point of Entry is the ADRC, where the assessment takes place. They are placed on the waitlist.

If you have questions about Medicaid eligibility please contact your local DCF office. If you have questions about physical disability determinations please contact your local Social Security Administration office.

The following services could be provided under the PD program as long as they are approved in your Plan of Care from the MCO.

- **Personal Services**
- **Assistive Services**
- **Sleep Cycle Support**
- **Personal Emergency Response Systems (PERS) and Installation**

Q. How long do people wait on the list?

A. As people are going on and off, we can't give a time frame.

Q. I had heard there was an attempt to eliminate the list?

A. We are still making offers.

Q. What are the roles of the ILRC playing in your attempt to find people?

A. We have not utilized them. We may look into that.

Q. Will you address how MFP works with this waiver?

A. We do have some referrals from the MCO's and identify those that might utilize that program.
