



Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Final Rule Public Comment Sessions

The Center for Medicaid & Medicare Service’s (CMS) HCBS Settings Final Rule is a set of federal requirements for all HCBS Waiver service settings aimed to ensure that HCBS settings truly are community based. States have been working with CMS to ensure their settings, regulations, and policies will comply with the final rule by March 17, 2019.

In Kansas, there are seven HCBS waivers:

- Frail Elderly (65+ years)
- Autism (child who starts services before age 6)
- Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (5+ years)
- Technology Assisted (0 through 21 years)
- Traumatic Brain Injury (16-64 years)
- Physical Disability (16-64 years)
- Serious Emotional Disturbance (0-18 years)

The Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services wants to give stakeholders additional opportunity for information and feedback on the compliance process.
