| 2 | Update on 1115 waiver | The waiver will be submitted early this week. The State is in ongoing conversations with CMS and has received positive feedback thus far. Few items have changed since the previous waiver submission. | Becky |
| 3 | Discussion of transportation concerns | Workgroup member concerns with the current program included the following issues: -Accessibility of transportation services -Limited access in rural areas -General issues with network of providers -No show and late show rates of providers -Frequent contract and reimbursement changes -No hotline accessibility from the State's contractor -Insufficient reimbursement -Issues with transport of mental health patients -Current contractor is generally unresponsive to provider concerns. | All |
| 4 | MCO brief presentations on transportation | Each of the three KanCare plans provided a brief overview of their plan for managing transportation. United will use Logisticare as a NEMT subcontractor, Sunflower will use MTM, and Amerigroup will use Access2Care. 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| 5 | Health homes timeline and review of progress | A concept paper will be submitted to CMS soon, which will begin our conversations with them. We are requesting planning money that will help the State begin to convene additional stakeholder groups to discuss health homes. | Becky |
| 6 | Health homes quality goals and measures | A subcommittee of the health homes planning team has been working to identify goals and associated measures that could be used to track progress. Effie reviewed the handout and described the subcommittee's approach to selecting measures. The workgroup provided feedback on the measures listed. | Effie |
