



## **Kansas Medical Assistance**

### **MediKan/General Assistance Program**

The MediKan program provides medical services for anyone receiving the General Assistance program from the Department for Children and Families (DCF).

The General Assistance (GA) program provides assistance to persons who have physical or mental disabilities. The GA program may provide medical services to people who would not qualify for other state or federal programs. Persons may only receive GA for 12 months. If you apply for GA benefits, you must also apply for Social Security disability benefits. If you are determined eligible for the GA program you will be sent a MediKan card that can be used to pay part or all of your medical bills. You must have very low income and resources to be eligible for the GA program. Some resources are exempt including:

- The home where you live;
- Assets under \$2000;
- Your car.
