
What Has Changed ?

- Medicaid Home and Community Based Services for the Frail Elderly
 - In 1996 responsibility was transferred from SRS
- HCBS waiver case management service transferred to Managed Care 1-1-2013
- Client Assessment Referral and Evaluation (CARE) Coordination
 - Program implemented by AAA's in 1995
- CARE Coordination program ended 12-31-2012

KanCare Changes

- Aging and Disability Resource Center– Statewide network of services
- A companion to KanCare – conflict free service model
- The Eleven AAA's provide ADRC services in 105 Counties
 - Three ADRC services provided
 1. Information, Referral and Assistance
 2. Options Assistance Counseling
 3. Functional Assessments

The ADRC Collectively Covers all 105 Counties

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ADRC– What is it?



- Originally established new service model in 2003
- Goal: System Integration –Long Term Service & Support System
- Highly visible single point of access
 - Simplifies access
 - Serves people of all ages, abilities and incomes
 - Single point of access for publicly administered programs

Kansas ADRC Functions



- Statewide Call Center Launched November 1, 2012
 - Managed by CPAAA – 1-855-200-ADRC (2372)
 - Information, referral and assistance
 - Warm transfers
 - Referrals for options assistance counseling
 - Intakes
 - Serves the general public

Kansas ADRC Functions



➤ Options Assistance Counseling

Assistance with identification of needs and options, long term planning, referrals for services for publicly funded and private pay resources

- Long term service options
- Decision making support
- Serves the general public

Kansas ADRC Functions



➤ Functional Assessments

- Frail Elders
- Physically Disabled
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Working Healthy
- Program of All Inclusive Care– PACE
 - Complete initial assessments and reassessments

Kansas ADRC Functions



- Nursing Facility Administration Assessment (CARE/PASRR)
 - Hospitals
 - Nursing Facilities
 - Community
 - PACE

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Community Based Services

- ▶ Caregiver Services
 - ▶ Legal Services
 - ▶ Private Pay Services
 - ▶ Senior Centers
 - ▶ Exercise Programs
 - ▶ Others based on community needs and resources
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Community Transition Programs

- ▶ Money Follows the Person (MFP)
 - Nursing Facility Refers to Managed Care Organizations (MCO)
- ▶ Community Transition Opportunities (CTO)
 - Nursing Facility Refers Through KAMIS

- ▶ The system for long term supports and services in Kansas continues to transition
 - The ADRC serves as the entry point
 - No Wrong Door service model continues to evolve and expand
- ▶ Community Based Services for seniors continue to be available through the Area Agencies on Aging (AAA's).
