

IDD TCM and Health Homes September 23, 2014

To ensure that IDD members are able to continue working with their targeted case managers (TCMs), Health Homes are encouraged to include the TCM provider for any Health Home member who has an intellectual or developmental disability (IDD) (as defined and determined according to K.S.A. 39-1803 and K.A.R. 30-64-23) and wishes to continue the relationship with his or her TCM provider. Anyone who meets the state's IDD eligibility definition and is Medicaid eligible can have a TCM, so people who may not qualify for the HCBS waiver or people who are waiting for an HCBS waiver slot also receive IDD TCM. The Lead Entity or the HHP is encouraged to contract with the TCM provider if the IDD member wishes to continue the relationship with that provider and both the TCM provider and the Lead Entity/HHP wish to contract with each other. For members who are assigned to a Health Home, TCM claims will not be allowed starting November 1, 2014 and going forward.

If Lead Entities/HHPs and TCM providers do contract, these contracts must be established with these TCM providers within 60 days of member assignment to a HHP for all assignments made September 1, 2014 forward. Contracts for members assigned to a Health Home prior to September 1, 2014 must be completed by October 31, 2014. If such contracts are entered into, Lead Entities/HHPs must provide a minimum payment of:

1. \$137.32 to TCM providers serving IDD SMI Health Home members who are on the HCBS waiver.
2. \$53.36 to TCM providers serving IDD SMI Health Home members who are not on the HCBS waiver.

The guarantee of \$53.36 for IDD members not on the IDD HCBS waiver is the average amount billed for all IDD members not on the IDD HCBS waiver who received TCM.

If Lead Entities/HHPs do not contract, the IDD HH member may:

1. Choose another TCM provider who is/will contract with the HHP;
2. Choose a different HHP who is contracted with their TCM provider;
3. Elect not to have a TCM provider as part of their Health Home; or,
4. Opt out of Health Homes, although TCM providers shall not exert pressure on IDD members to opt out of Health Homes. (Please refer to *Rules of Conduct for Case Managers Serving People With Developmental Disabilities* found at:

An Update to SMI HH Program Manual will be made:

Lead Entities (MCOs) and/or HHPs are encouraged to include the targeted case management (TCM) provider as part of the Health Homes team for any member who has an intellectual or developmental disability (IDD) and wishes to continue the relationship with that provider. The Lead Entity or the HHP must provide a minimum PMPM payment of:

1. \$137.32 to TCM providers serving IDD SMI Health Home members who are on the HCBS waiver.
2. \$53.36 to TCM providers serving IDD SMI Health Home members who are not on the HCBS waiver.
