Extra benefits with Healthy Blue

- Members aged 18 and older who complete their annual doctor visit are eligible to receive one of the following, worth up to **\$75**: a gift card for gas, a Rideshare gift card, a gift card for an oil change, support for public transportation, or a AAA membership.

- Members aged 21 and older can receive an extra **\$500** per year for specialty dental services that aren't covered under KanCare.
- Members who complete their annual doctor visit are eligible to receive a **\$75** gift card to use for over-the-counter items that support health and personal hygiene.
- Young members between the ages of 5 and 17 can get a **\$200** gift card that can be used to enroll in summer camps.
- Members 21+ can receive an additional **\$75** allowance toward eyeglass frames or contacts.
- General Education Development (GED) assistance to support schooling and job pursuits

Support for parents and kids

Pregnancy support with:

- Gift card rewards for completing prenatal and postpartum visits
- No-cost health support and coaching
- Diapers, healthy grocery cards, and other mom and baby essentials

Special services for members who qualify
