Extra help for HCBS waiver members**

Over-the-counter support:

LTSS members get \$100* per year for health items.

Weighted blanket or sensory weighted vest:

Members in the Autism and SED waivers or in Foster Care can request, for support with anxiety.

Walmart+ Membership:

For adult members in care coordination, pregnant, or with mobility issues.

Medication Lockbox:

Members enrolled in care coordination or pregnant can request one per household.

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
