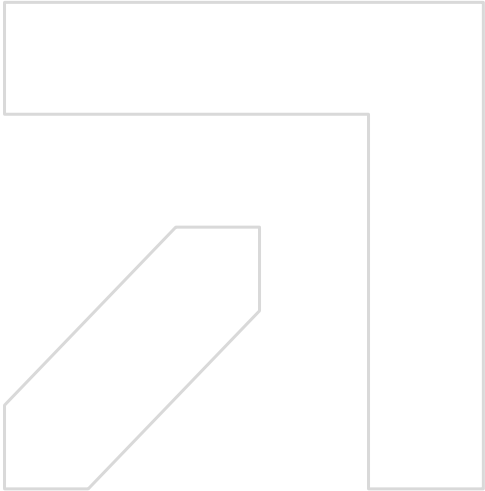

- **Only** paid claims can be adjusted.
- Denied claims **must be rebilled** with the correct codes, dates and units.
- Denied claims **cannot** be voided or adjusted.

Avoiding Overbilling



Consider when billing

Accuracy of Information is key!

- All provider identifiers need to be current and correct
- Asterisks=required
- Importance of receiving provider and NPI (credentialing)
- Dates are important
- Provider should maintain their credentials for accurate billing. Provider Enrollment does require providers to revalidate every 3 years
- Claims are processed according to the rules that are set in KMAP
- Bulletin and manual updates - any changes to requirements are found here

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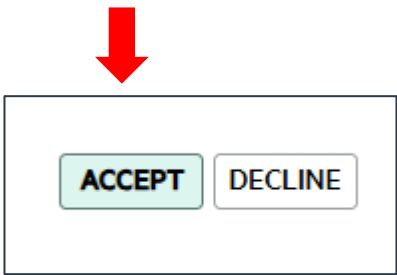

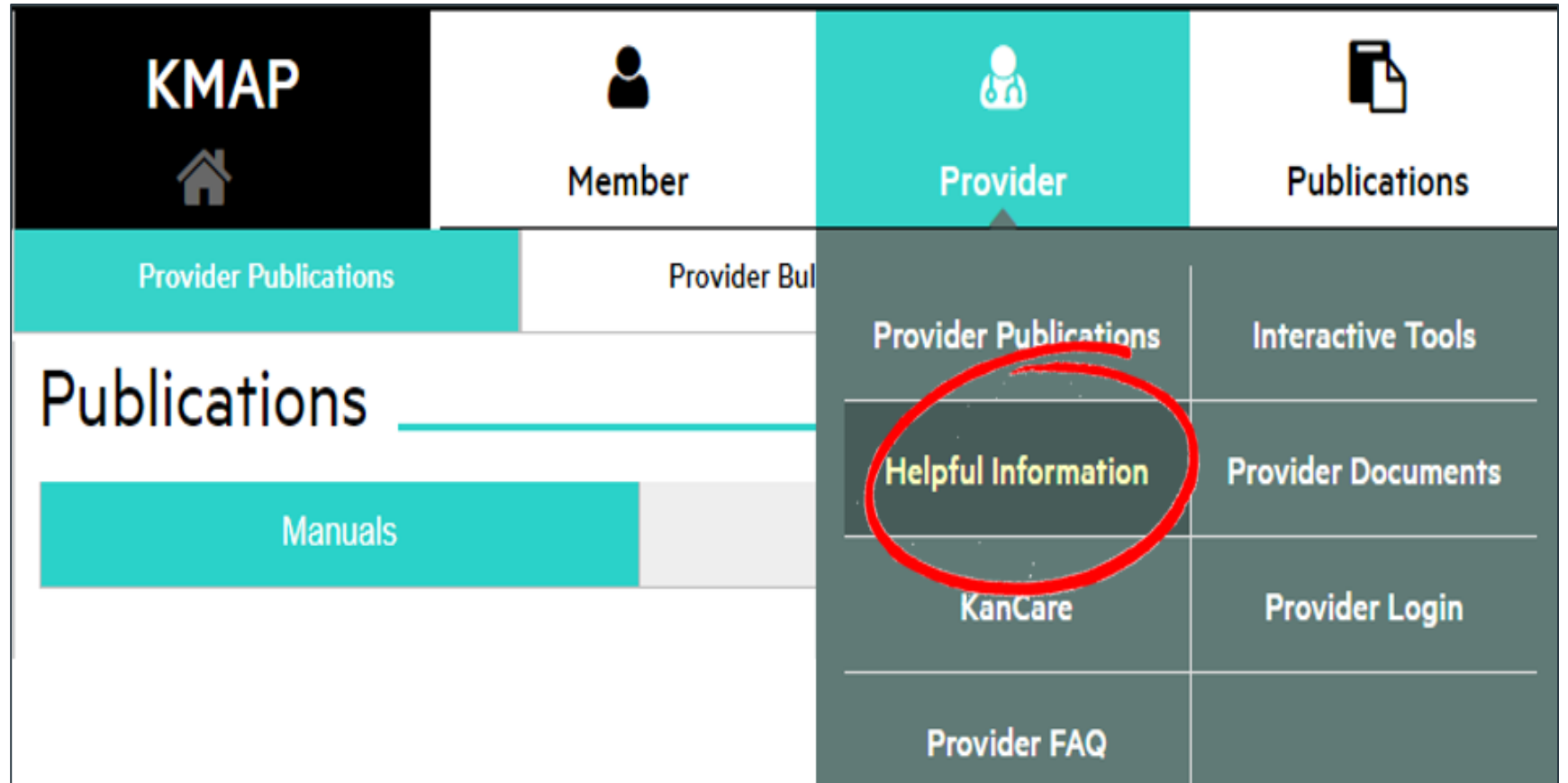
